The town of "Angiola" is 1/2 mile from above mentioned place.

Hall & Cap. Hunter have a good place, are putting in alfalfa now.

Will drop you a line tomorrow & tell you how the 2600 acre place looks to me.

Saw Joe Seri, from Nevada in the city yesterday eve, before leaving says cattle are very cheap up there lots have not sold for two years those who did sold for \$25 3's & up steers, just think!!

Now if I can I am going to get about 1000 steers, bring them here & fatten, & sell. Early in the spring on best early market now is the chance for a quick turn & nice profit.

No news here.

This is a 9 month old town, excursions every Tuesday lots doing, "very much excite", every body.
