There is a boat going out to-morrow, so will drop you another line, nothing to write of int. I can think of. I finished drilling for Kittleson this A.M. I kept full accts. of everything and find I can pay all and \$12.50 per day for the drill and make \$103.00 in 4 1/2 days net.

Pa wants me to go prospect 4 claims on Shovel Creek after the 15th inst. then I am to go to Gold Run and report, Pa just to hear all if and etc.

The Saratoga is the boat that is going to sail to-morrow, its a freighter and a new one, carries about 50 passengers.

The Ohio and Orozaba left here at the same time, last trip the Ohio reached Seattle about half an hour ahead, the Oro. is aid to be a 17n boat. I don't know what time the boat sails, to-morrow, may not have time to post this, but can give it to some one to post in Seattle, did you get the one with the \$20.00 in it?

I put a letter in the office for Dan yesterday, tell him I was very much pleased with the postal he sent me.

Ma just came in, has been visiting this eve, called on Mrs. LaFarge.

It's now 10 P.M. and I have nothing at all to write, only I am getting so lonesome I am getting nutty or nearly so. Maggie is sitting here "belly aching" says give you her best regards.
