Now I won't try to write you any more as I will be going out on the next Ohio which sails about the 18th of Oct. That will put me in Seattle say 27th will start to Detroit the 28th and reach Detroit by the first of Nov.

This is the last day for our deal but I don't think anything will be done.

Well Tom and bill are having a set too on the statement business, just started.

I went to Mystery ten days ago but water only lasted long enough to get half washed up.

Have taken out 225 1/4 oz. making 3941.875 since you left about one half of it is washed, we won't any more than come out even and may go a little behind.

Now I won't wire you when I start from here, but will wire after I get out, before I get to Detroit.

I weigh 147 lbs how is that? Don't answer because I will see you before I could get an answer.

I won't try to say much, I will write any time I see a chance to get a letter off to you.
