My dearest -

Am still here & it looks as if the ice will not permit our going to Teller by water for several weeks yet so I guess about two of us will strike out for Kugerrock a foot in two or three days, will take about six days to walk it. Ma and Lizzie R. just started over to see Ila for a little while.

The C.D. Lane and St. Paul are expected at any time now, both were seen at Dutch Harbor a few days ago. O.K. Am going out to Louis' mine to-morrow they are washing the gravel they took out during the winter.

I am going to send you a few little trinkets on the next boat that goes out. Nothing to write this time. Will write again before this letter can get off.
